Qualifications

- All works of art should include RECYCLABLE or RECYCLED materials (paper, newspaper, cardboard, tin, aluminum, glass, plastic, etc.) that have previously served another purpose. Creative use of “throwaways” (items usually discarded in the trash) is encouraged.
- Size of entry is limited to 2 feet high x 2 feet wide x 2 feet deep.
- Students of Pasco County schools (public/private/home school).
- Must be original work of the exhibitor created within the past year.
- Laws prohibit use of copyrighted materials and designs—If used, entry will be disqualified.

Entry Procedures

1. Exhibitor's name, address, and phone number should be printed on entry form, along with a brief paragraph describing the artwork. Be sure to identify category, age group, and sign. Attach form to back of entry.
2. Entry deadline: All entries must be delivered to the Extension Office at the Pasco County Fairgrounds, 36702 State Road 52, Dade City by **Friday, February 1, 2008**. Office hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
3. Pick-up date: Items and prizes may be picked up after Wednesday, February 27, 2008 from the Extension Office.

Judging

1. Items will be judged by two or more professionals on Wednesday, February 6, 2008.
2. Judges will determine 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in each category/age group. Winners will receive ribbons (blue/red/white) and prizes. One "Best-of-Show" rosette will be awarded for overall achievement. The winning entries will be on display at the Pasco County Fair, February 18-24, 2008. Each participant will receive a 4-H participation ribbon.
